What is CASA?

Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) ensures that children in the Juvenile Abuse and Neglect Court system have courtroom advocacy and access to services and resources. CASA volunteers are the voice for children in the courtroom; reporting to the court and keeping the children's needs and wishes at the forefront of pertinent decisions regarding their future.

What is CASAblanca - Dancing with the (Local) Stars?

- Last Fiscal Year, CASA of the Tenth Judicial Circuit served 488 children. There are approximately 1,500 pending abuse and neglect cases in the Tenth Judicial Circuit. The need is great!
- The number of children moving through the abuse and neglect courtroom is extremely high, but CASA is ready to recruit volunteers to advocate for these children, and needs funding to train, support and supervise their efforts.
